Cambridge Advanced Executive Coaching Programme

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the entry requirements?

We ask that applicants have experience as a coach or a qualification in coaching or a related subject. We review applications on a case-by-case basis and seek to fully understand your background and experience, so we encourage you to get in touch with the team to check whether you are eligible.

If English is not your native language, a high-level English language proficiency is crucial, as all sessions are delivered in English and assignments must be submitted in English.

Do I need to complete the Cambridge Online Business Coaching Programme before applying for this programme?

If you have completed the Cambridge Online Business Coaching Programme, this programme is the next natural step in your development, and this step has been purposefully designed as a continuous journey. However, it is not the only route to entry and is not a requirement for the Cambridge Advanced Executive Coaching Programme.

How long does the programme application process take?

Once you have submitted your application, we aim to respond within 10 working days. Our internal selection panel will evaluate the application, and you will be contacted via email if we have any questions and requests for further information. We then invite applicants for an application call with the Coaching Programmes Manager. Following the application call, we inform you of the final outcome within 7 working days.

If your application is successful, your place will be reserved for a limited amount of time and will be confirmed upon receipt of the programme fees.

What is the difference between the fee options?

We have two types of programme fees: the Programme fee and the Residential Programme fee. The Programme fee includes the full development programme, all learning content, materials, intermodular support, virtual sessions, supervisions, and refreshments and lunches during modules.

The Residential Programme fee includes the full programme, plus accommodation and breakfast. As this programme includes in-person modules, you are welcome to stay on-site in our purpose-built leadership development centre in the grounds of Churchill College for each module. Staying on-site provides a really immersive experience, with the chance to build relationships with the cohort. You have the option of choosing between 3 nights per module (9 nights in total) or 4 nights per module (12 nights in total). This is entirely optional, as some participants prefer to make alternative arrangements.

How is the programme structured?

The programme is eight months in total, including three in-person modules, which are held in Cambridge.

In between each module, there is coaching practice and assignments, along with virtual supervisions and group sessions.

How much time will I need to dedicate to this programme?

We suggest participants dedicate roughly 6-7 hours per week outside of the in-person modules for this programme. This time includes your coaching practice, supervision, and extra reading.

Many of our participants complete the programme alongside full or part-time employment. Like any significant development programme, it does require time investment to get the most out of the experience and complete the programme successfully, and so balancing the programme in this way can be intensive. However, it is very achievable, and our programme team is there to support you at every step.

Can I complete this programme online?

We have intentionally designed this programme with in-person experiences to support the depth of learning and development that is required of advanced coaching capability. Whilst there are online or self-guided elements between the modules, in-person attendance at each module is required. We feel this contributes to the programme's outcomes and helps you to build connections within the cohort, who will become your support network during the programme.

Is there an assessment?

The successful completion of this programme depends on a number of things, including:

- ♦ attendance and engagement in all three in-person modules;
- ♦ the completion of 60 hours of coaching practice in your own time, with written logs as evidence of your reflections and progress;
- ♦ the submission of a coaching case study assignment, a personal coaching approach assignment, and a reflective journal;
- ♦ and the completion of a live coaching observation, which is the formal assessment where you are observed as a coach and offered feedback.

Is the programme accredited?

Yes, the programme is accredited to the Advanced Diploma in Coach Training (AADT) level with the Association for Coaching, the highest level offered. In addition, we are part of an accelerated application process with the Association for Coaching that allows you to apply to become an Accredited Coach after the programme. Our programme team fully support you with this process.

Will I be an Accredited Coach at the end of this programme?

We are part of an accelerated application process with the Association for Coaching that allows you to apply to become an Accredited Coach after the programme. Subject to the number of formal coaching hours you have completed in addition to the hours required for programme completion, you are eligible to apply for Executive Coach accreditation at any level offered by the Association for Coaching. Our programme team fully support you with this process.

The accelerated application process takes place directly with the Association for Coaching after programme completion. It is an online application process and is subject to the Association's accreditation fees.
